AutoCAD has become very popular over the years, with over 40 million active users as of January 2020. It is used by architects, mechanical engineers, civil engineers, drafters, surveyors, electricians, attorneys, and homebuilders. It is commonly used in fields such as power, transportation, agriculture, construction, heavy equipment, and architecture. It is often used for creating blueprints, to calculate quantities, for controlling manufacturing processes, and for creating maps and graphs. It is also used in 2D and 3D CAD animation. History AutoCAD was introduced as "AutoCAD Architecture", and was initially sold only as an architectural drafting package for the Apple II and IBM PC, and for the Apple III in 1984, but was soon expanded to other applications for the Apple Macintosh, in the form of Metacad and CadNav. AutoCAD's first release was for Apple II. As of May 1993, AutoCAD was available on 31 different platforms, and had been ported to dozens more. It was first available for the Apple II, Apple III, Commodore 64, IBM PC compatible, Atari 8-bit family, Amstrad CPC, Oric, PC DOS, Atari ST, Macintosh, and MS-DOS. Early releases were written in AppleSoft BASIC. The first version on IBM PC was released in 1982. The first release for the Macintosh was version 2.0 in 1985. AutoCAD for the Amiga platform was released in 1990, for the Apple Mac Classic in 1992, for the Atari ST in 1993, and for the Windows and Linux platforms in 1996. The first version for Windows was for Windows 3.0 in 1996. Pricing and version history AutoCAD was originally priced at about \$1,000 for the Apple II (or at the higher prices of that era), and about \$5,000 for the IBM PC. AutoCAD

version 2.0 was the first release to be priced at the standard CAD pricing structure, at \$1,500. The transition to a standard CAD pricing structure resulted in large growth in its market share, which was at first 40 percent, but rose to over 75 percent within 5 years. As of September 2006, AutoCAD is priced at around \$3,500, and is available in many editions, ranging from the "Express Edition" to the "Gold Edition". A free trial version of AutoCAD is available for download, in addition to demo versions of Autodesk

The term "plug-in" is often used to describe an Cracked AutoCAD With Keygen extension. This is a misnomer. Plug-ins are usually extensions to an application (e.g., Word, Paint, Flash) that replace the original program with one provided by the vendor. AutoCAD Crack For Windows extensions are usually written as stand-alone programs that interact with AutoCAD in an application-like fashion. These extensions do not replace the original AutoCAD application. Although standard AutoCAD is free, a full version of AutoCAD LT is available for a fee. AutoCAD LT can be downloaded and installed on Windows, Linux, and Mac OS X.

Autodesk also sells a host of add-on and plug-in software and product extensions that extend AutoCAD functionality. These include feature packs, plug-ins, applications, and AutoCAD-based software. A plug-in is a software component that can be used to extend the capabilities of a program. It is typically loaded as a module in the operating system, and therefore is available only to the program that loaded it. There are several kinds of plug-ins, but usually they are shared libraries that the program dynamically loads. AutoCAD's common drawing system is based on a visual programming language that uses a set of commands called "layers". The layers allow users to construct a drawing by laying out objects and components, including text, solids, and bitmaps, and to connect these objects into a tree-like hierarchy of layers. This allows drawings to be constructed and edited in any order, and allows users to extend the AutoCAD drawing system by developing their own new layers, known as "plug-ins". History AutoCAD was first developed in 1985 by Albert Hausmann at Remco Software in Neuilly sur Seine, France. It was first shipped in 1986. In 1988, Hausmann sold the software to Hewlett-Packard (HP). HP had several failed attempts at acquiring Remco, including its predecessor Inc-Graphics. After the purchase of Remco by HP, it was renamed AutoCAD, Ltd.

In 1991, the first version of AutoCAD released by HP was renamed AutoCAD LT, which allowed commercial use. The software that was released at this time was not compatible with the earlier versions of AutoCAD. The first version of AutoCAD LT was based on the 1991 V1 release of AutoCAD a1d647c40b
