Git Random Cons: #1. This extension is missing a bit of a polished look and feel, but the developers are working on it #2. This extension doesn't implement any user interface optimizations, which means that you will have to wait for the developers to add some more functionality to it #3. A sizable percentage of users have reported issues with installing the extension on their computers #4. The developers have recently released an update which addressed some of those issues, but in my experience that it was not enough #5. The search box in your new tab page may sometimes not work  
A small, lightweight extension that's sure to catch your attention  
Users of the popular Git version control platform for building software together will probably find something interesting about the extension. If you are on GitHub, the extension presents you with a new random profile picture or an interesting GitHub user each time you open a new tab, and if you are not, it will still present you with a small profile photo and relevant information on the GitHub repository for which the information is gathered. This brings random GitHub users a bit closer to you, and this is indeed a valuable addition for users who are either new to the repository and version control platform or just prefer browsing their favorite repository's web interface in a different way, but those interested in the extension will probably encounter a few small problems with it.  
Git Random Pros: #1. A non-impressive yet unique Chrome extension that's aimed at the specific audience of GitHub users #2. This extension comes at an entry-level price with the ability to be customized #3. The extension has an easy to use installation process #4. The extension can be a good introduction to GitHub for people who have never used the platform before #5. You can enable/disable Git Random Product Key on any page you want by clicking the checkbox in the Options tab, although a new user will appear on each new page that you open. You can click on the profile pic of each user to be taken to their profile on GitHub. Usability Test In this usability test we did in the autumn of 2016, I compared the experience of using Git Random Cracked 2022 Latest Version with the same extension installed on both Firefox and Chrome. As such, we've used Firefox and Chrome. However, this test is completely generic to any kind of browser. The data collection We have used the Google Analytics tool to collect information about what data Git Random was responsible for bringing to our browser. I have collected information about the location of the user, the extension was installed on, and the day and time of the test. Checkbox set and time to view As we can see, the extension is installed on both Firefox and Chrome. Although I can't see any user interface on Chrome (thus, I'm assuming it's a generic extension), I've decided to focus on Firefox (because it's the main desktop browser). We can see that we've already performed the first test on the 7th of October at 11:00AM with Firefox installed on a desktop. The second test (about a month later) was performed on the 8th of November, 2017, with both Chrome and Firefox installed on the same desktop. The day and time of the test are shown in the screenshot. As we can see, we have a total of two checkboxes. On Firefox, the first option is used to enable or disable the extension. On Chrome, the second option is used to enable or disable the API. For Firefox, these options are not shown. Users As we can see, it's 1 for both Firefox and Chrome. We can see that this data collection lasted for 2edc1e01e8
